### SATURDAY JUNE 20<sup>TH</sup>

Pre-Registration Fee of \$20.00 with pre-registration ending on June 13, 2008. Pre-registration is not required for the June ride but is greatly appreciated for planning of meals.

Day of the Ride fee is \$30.00 Rain Date is Sunday June 21<sup>nd</sup>

Riders Meeting will be held @ 9:30 a.m. with the ride starting at 10:00 a.m. Please be at the farm by 9:15 a.m. so you can get your ATV unloaded and registration taken care of. Lunch will be available on the trail for additional cost. Showers and camping are available and bring your own fire wood.

### SATURDAY JULY 18<sup>th</sup>

Pre-Registration Fee of \$20.00 with pre-registration ending on July 11, 2008. Pre-registration is not required for the July ride but is greatly appreciated for planning of meals.

Day of the Ride \$30.00 Rain Date is Sunday July 19<sup>th</sup>

Riders Meeting will be held @9:30 a.m. with the ride starting at 10:00 a.m. Please be at the farm by 9:15 a.m. so you can get your ATV unloaded and registration taken care of. Lunch will be available on the trial for additional cost. Showers and camping are available and bring your own fire wood.

### SEPTEMBER 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>TH</sup> THE 2 – DAY RIDE

Registration Fee of \$80.00 for the weekend with registration ending on September 12, 2009 or until the limit of 250 is reached. PRE-REGISTRATION is required for the two-day ride in September and we will be accepting entries on a first come, first serve basis. The registration fee includes: Saturday - coffee &

donuts, lunch and sit-down dinner with beer provided and Sunday - breakfast and lunch, and pop for the weekend. There will be rider's meetings both mornings at 9:30 a.m. with the rides starting at 10:00 a.m. The track will be open on Friday night AFTER you register. Registration will start at 3:30 p.m. on Friday afternoon. Showers and camping are available and bring your own fire wood.

There will be **NO ONE-DAY PASSES** for the 2-day ride. You may ride for one day but the fee will remain the same. Please fill out and mail the enclosed registration form with the appropriate fees. When returning the registration form(s) please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope (SASE) so we can mail back your two day ride ticket(s). **\*\*Please plan on attending no matter the weather!! There will be camping, food, and fun. We cannot control the weather and we will ride as much as we can, there will be NO REFUNDS GIVEN. \*\***

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. A HELMET IS REQUIRED TO RIDE!!!! All riders must wear a DOT, SNELL, or other approved helmet, protective eyewear, and over the ankle foot wear;
2. 10 MPH speed limit on camp grounds & farm yards
3. The ATV Club is NOT responsible for accidents or thefts
4. NO ALCOHOL is permitted during the ride and do not leave any litter on the trails

5. You **MUST STAY ON TRAILS** and **NO PASSING** at anytime
6. Committee decisions are final
7. Rules may be added/changed at the discretion of the **ATV Club**
8. All attachments (plows etc) **MUST** be removed
9. Above all - Please use common sense and practice safety at all times.
10. Riders **MUST BE** 12 years of age w/parental supervision and must have a safety certificate as required by state law
11. All riders under the age of 18 **MUST** have a parent's signature **\*\*Please see registration form**

NOTE: There will be several divided groups for you to choose from - fast, medium, or slow. Our trails are privately owned and **NOT** state trails. Most are heavily wooded with a single lane and have steep hill climbs and easy-out side trails. These trails are truly unique, making the ride fun and challenging, even to the experienced rider.
