The Trempealeau County ATV trails are a series of private trail systems that offer something for every skill level, from the inclines of the bluffs to the valleys and swamps.

All registrations post marked by the early bird date listed below per event will be entered in a drawing to have a chance to be reimbursed the cost of that event (*Must include payment at time of registering, winner will be reimbursed day of the event*). SATURDAY JUNE 24th and / or June 25th (Rain date July 15 & 16)

The June event offers a weekend of riding - Riders choose to ride one or both days. Food and Beverages will be provided on the trail both days, at the cost of the rider.

- \$20.00 per Day - Pre-Registration Fee post marked by June 15, 2017
 - EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION – Must be post marked by June 1, 2017
- \$30.00 per Day – Registration Fee post marked after June 15, 2017
 - *Registration cost is per machine only, no charge for passengers.*
 - *Pre-registration is not required for the June ride but is greatly appreciated for planning of meals.*

 - *Event includes: Day(s) of Riding, Camping (No electric or water hookups, and must bring own fire wood) Shower, Lunch and Beverages at the cost of the rider(s)*

SEPTEMBER 16th & 17th THE 2 – DAY RIDE

The September event is a Full weekend of riding, registration for this ride includes food and beverages for all guests (see details below). Due to planning and preparation this ride is limited to 200 riders and you MUST PREREGISTER, entries accepted are first come first serve.

- \$100.00 per Machine (cost includes driver fee)
 - EARLY BIRD REGISTRATION – Must be post marked by September 1, 2017
- \$50.00 per Passenger over 12 yrs old, under 12 is Free
 - **When returning the registration form(s) please enclose a Self-addressed Stamped Envelope so we can mail back your two day ride ticket(s).**
 - *There will be NO ONE-DAY PASSES for this event, you may ride for one day but the fee will remain the same.*
 - *Event includes: Full weekend of Riding, Camping (No electric or water hookups, and must bring firewood), Shower, Auction, Home cooked food and Beverages (beer on Saturday night):*
 - *Saturday - Coffee/donuts, Lunch and Dinner*
 - *Sunday - Hot breakfast and Lunch*
 - **NO SAME DAY REGISTRATIONS ACCEPTED FOR THIS EVENT**
 - **REGISTRATION MUST BE POST MARKED BY THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 7TH 2017.**
 - **There will be NO REFUNDS GIVEN**

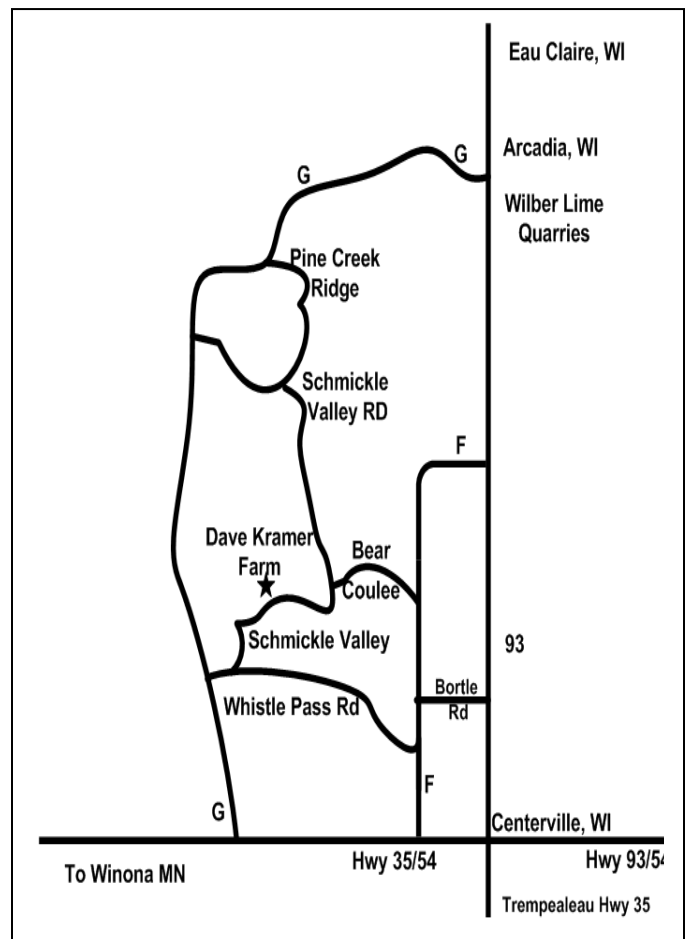

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. A HELMET IS REQUIRED TO RIDE!!!!
All riders must wear a DOT, SNELL, or other approved helmet, protective eyewear, and over the ankle foot wear.
2. 10 MPH speed limit on camp grounds & farm yards.
3. The ATV Club is NOT responsible for accidents or thefts.
4. NO ALCOHOL is permitted during the ride and do not leave any litter on the trails.
5. You MUST STAY ON TRAILS and NO PASSING at any time.
6. Committee decisions are final.
7. Rules may be added/changed at the discretion of the ATV Club.
8. All attachments (plows etc.) MUST be removed
9. Above all, please use common sense and practice safety at all times.
10. Riders MUST BE 12 years of age w/parental supervision and must have a safety certificate as required by state law.
11. All riders under the age of 18 MUST have a parent's signature – * See registration form.

NOTE: There will be several groups for you to choose from – fast, medium, or slow. Our trails are privately owned and NOT state trails.
